Whether fabric is stretched from wind or body movement, seams bear the brunt of the stress. Needle holes enlarge and sewn material pulls away to leave paths for water to seep through. Seam Sealer coats these areas with an invisible non-silicone waterproof barrier that doesn't change the fabric's feel, flexibility or color.

Iosso Seam Sealer works equally well on both natural fabrics like duck cotton and synthetics such as acrylic and polyester. Depending on the construction, it can even work with vinyl and vinyl laminates. This makes it ideal for a wide range of outdoor gear such as clothing, awnings, biminis, tents, and boat and RV covers.

Seam Sealer can be used to repair existing outdoor gear or as a preventive measure on new equipment. Easy to use, it has a built-in sponge applicator that's run along both sides of the seam. Once the seam and stitching are thoroughly saturated, they should dry for 24 hours. Made in the USA, a 4 oz. container of Iosso Seam Sealer costs \$8.52.
