MAGNETIC COMPASS DESIGNED SPECIFICALLY FOR KAYAKS

Whether exploring a mangrove forest in Florida or a secluded island in Puget Sound, it's critical that paddlers know where they are—especially if overcome by rain or fog. The Kayaker XP-99 magnetic compass from Ritchie Navigation was specifically designed for use on kayaks. And for those who don't want to permanently install it, the K-TD.2 Kayaker Tie Down accessory facilitates temporary use.

Made in the USA, the low-profile Kayaker XP-99 is available with a black or blue 2-3/4" direct-reading dial set atop a hardened steel movement with a scientifically-matched sapphire bearing. Powerful DirectiveForce™ magnets provide fast and smooth heading lock-on, even in choppy water. It's offered with a rugged black or white composite housing.

Unlike a GPS, the Kayaker XP-99 displays the heading when stopped or moving slowly. A course minder movable bezel with heading memory indicator makes staying on track easy. For dim and dark conditions, the compass can be illuminated with the optional LED lighting kit.

The K-TD.2 Kayaker Tie Down allows the XP-99 compass to be used without drilling holes. It attaches the compass to the boat using four high-strength bungee cords with integrated clips. A flexible foam pad conforms to the deck shape and keeps the device from moving.

Backed by a five-year warranty and 100% repairable, the Ritchie Navigation Kayaker XP-99 costs \$96.45. The Kayaker Tie Down is \$58.25.
