COMPASS GUIDES FISHERMEN HOME IN BAD CONDITIONS

Inland and coastal fishermen typically use landmarks to find their way. But when fog, heavy rain or darkness obscures shoreside references, the RitchieAngler magnetic compass from Ritchie Navigation is ready to guide them home. Made in the USA, it's the ideal addition to any small fishing boat or kayak.

The 2-3/4" high-visibility blue direct-read dial of the RitchieAngler has bright white heading letters, 30° numbering and 5° division marks. A yellow lubber line provides easy reference from a distance. The dial spins on a sapphire jewel that's set atop a hardened steel pivot movement for smooth operation, even in choppy conditions. Powerful DirectiveForce™ magnets ensure the heading display is quick and precise.

Designed specifically for fishing, the housing of the RitchieAngler is made from a durable no-glare gray polymer. A movable sun shield and integrated 12V green internal illumination make the compass useful no matter the conditions. A red lamp is optionally available, as are models wired for 6V and 24V.

The RitchieAngler is offered in two styles. Version RA-93 surface mounts and features convenient push-button removal for quick storage and safeguarding. It measures 3.6" L x 3.9" W x 3.3" H. The RA-91 compass

comes with a bracket with easily adjustable thumbscrews to optimize the installation angle. It's 4.7" L x 4.4" W x 5.3" H. Both models include built-in compensators to adjust for deviation when installed on or near metal.

Ritchie Navigation's Ritchie Angler models RA-93 and RA-91 are 100% repairable and backed by a five-year warranty. Each costs \$103.33.
