FOR A SOLAS COMPASS, THE CHOICE IS GLOBEMASTER

SOLAS standards require merchant vessels to have a properly adjusted magnetic compass onboard. The obvious choice for commercial mariners is the 5" Globemaster Binnacle from Ritchie Navigation. Seen on the decks of workboats worldwide, it's available with numerous options including quadrantal correctors to accommodate a wide range of applications.

The Globemaster Binnacle has a black PowerDamp card and is offered with white 2° or 2° with points or 5° marks. A 90° lubber line is easy to view from a distance. The card is set atop a full internal hardened steel, jeweled-bearing gimbal system with built-in compensators. This provides a steady, accurate heading reading without spinning or jumping even in rough sea conditions. For installation on a steel-hulled boat or around heavy metal components, the option of quadrantal correctors makes adjusting for deviation—and complying with SOLAS—easy.

All Globemaster Binnacle compasses come with an integrated sliding hood. The housings have an anti-vibration mounting system and are offered in three finishes: long-wearing black wrinkle paint, chromed brass and polished stainless. Green or red 12V, 24V or 32V LED lighting is standard.

The Ritchie Navigation 5" D-515 Globemaster Binnacle compass starts at \$1,828.34; the D-5-S model with quadrantal correctors at \$2,458.25. They are 100% repairable and come with a five-year warranty.
