RECOVERY MOUNT MARKS SEASUCKER'S OFF-ROAD DEBUT

SeaSucker, manufacturer of innovative automotive and marine accessories, makes its debut into the off-road market with its new Recovery Mounts. Simple to use, they secure rescue boards and jacks to a vehicle without making modifications and remove without leaving a trace.

Made in the USA, Recovery Mounts start with a set of three 6" SeaSucker Vacuum Mounts that adhere to any smooth, non-porous surface. Unlike common suction cups that lose holding power soon after they're applied, each holds an astounding 210 lbs—enough to keep a heavy jack in place over rough terrain. They install with a few pumps of the integrated power button. When it's time to stow the gear, the mounts remove instantly, making them ideal for vehicles that double as a daily drive.

Each SeaSucker Vacuum Mount includes a threaded stud and anodized aluminum lock knob. Attached first to slots in the rescue boards or jack, the mounts are then secured to the vehicle. Highly adaptable, they can be applied horizontally across the hood or roof, or vertically across the side without any loss to their holding power.

Recovery Mounts hold up to two recovery boards or one recovery jack. A set of three costs \$219.
