ROOF RACK SOLUTION IDEAL FOR RV USE

Whether it's a rugged overland 4x4 camper van or large Class A motorhome, stowing gear on an RV roof is often a challenge, especially if permanent installation isn't wanted. With a set of SeaSucker Monkey Bars, it's easy to carry kayaks, canoes, bikes and other large items up to 150 pounds.

Made in the USA, SeaSucker Monkey Bars are offered in 48" and 60" widths. Travel-friendly, each round black powder-coated aluminum crossbar unscrews in half from the machined aluminum center coupler for easier storage and to safeguard them from theft.

Monkey Bars utilize SeaSucker's innovative Vacuum Mounts. With four on the front crossbar and two on the rear, they offer a combined holding force of 1,260 pounds—even at highway speeds. The cups adhere to any non-porous surface such as painted metal, fiberglass and/or glass. Because installation doesn't rely on a structural part of the roof such as a rain gutter, they're easy to place around vents, skylights and A/C units. Six protective covers are included to keep the cups clean and retain their shape.

Once the Vacuum Mounts are adjusted for the optimal location, securing them is as easy as pumping their integrated power buttons. When the high-visibility orange indicator bands disappear, the Monkey Bars are
